## Methodology

The results are based on omnibus questions placed on an Environics' North of 60° and Remote Community Monitor, conducted with a representative sample of adult Canadians living above the 60<sup>th</sup> parallel. The survey was conducted by telephone between May 10 and June 14, 2005.

### Question Design

The questions were designed by representatives from the Department of Canadian Heritage with input from senior Environics researchers. The questions were pre-tested as part of the overall survey, prior to being finalized.

### Sample Selection

The sampling method was designed to complete approximately 1,350 interviews within households randomly selected across the four regions of Canada's North – Yukon, Northwest Territories, Nunavut, and Nunavik – as well as in Labrador. Sample was drawn from listed telephone numbers in the most recently published directories of the five regions. Interviews were conducted based on quotas for Aboriginal status.

From within each household contacted, respondents 18 years of age and older were screened for random selection using the “most recent birthday” method. The use of this technique produces results that are as valid and effective as enumerating all persons within a household and selecting one randomly.

In the data analysis, the results of the survey were weighted to reflect the actual proportion of over- and under-sampled segments in the population. For this survey, results have been weighted by gender, age, and by Aboriginal status by region, based on available census data.

The final sample is distributed as follows.

## Telephone Interviewing

Interviewing for this survey was conducted at Environics’ central facilities in Toronto. Field supervisors were present at all times to ensure accurate interviewing and recording of responses. Ten percent of each interviewer's work was unobtrusively monitored for quality control in accordance with the standards set out by the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association (MRIA). A minimum of five calls were made to a household before classifying it as a “no answer”.

## Completion Results

A total of 1,349 interviews were completed for this survey. A sample of this size will produce a sampling error of plus or minus 2.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. The margin of error is greater for results pertaining to regional or socio-demographic subgroups of the total sample.

The effective response rate is nine percent: the number of completed interviews (1,349) divided by the total dialled sample (28,982) minus the non-valid/non-residential numbers, the numbers not in service, ineligible households as well as those that presented a language barrier (13,506). The actual completion rate is 17 percent: the number of completed interviews (1,349) divided by the number of qualified respondents contacted directly (8,091). The following table presents the detailed completion results.
