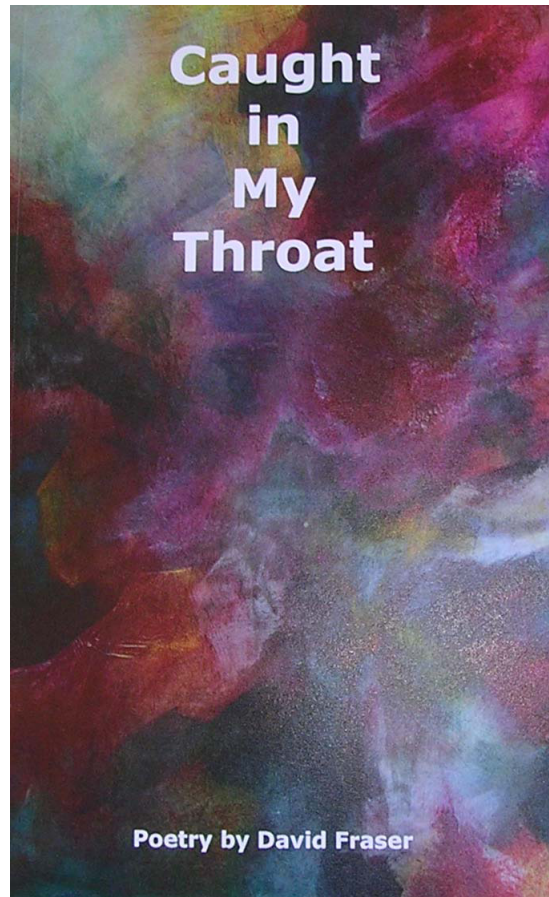


Press Release
