Correction to “Screening for lung cancer”

CMAJ has been made aware of an error that occurred in the May 13, 2014, issue.¹

In point 1, the number “274” should have been “247” in the sentence, “Evidence from a systematic review showed that, after a mean follow-up of 6.5 years, screening for lung cancer with CT in high-risk groups was associated with a reduction in deaths from the disease, from 309 to 274 per 100 000 person-years, for a relative risk reduction of 20.0% (95% confidence interval 6.8%–26.7%).”
