The Pre-Employment Polygraph (PEP) Interview and Examination is part of the RCMP Regular Member Recruiting Process. The PEP is used to assist in determining suitability and reliability, and to contribute to the security screening assessment of a RCMP Regular Member Applicant.

You, as the Applicant, must first complete the Regular Member Applicant Questionnaire, Pre-Employment Suitability, Reliability and Security Polygraph Interview and Examination (referred to herein as the Applicant Questionnaire). The questions contained in this Applicant Questionnaire pertain to your **honesty, integrity** and **ethics**. Should you be successful at all preceding stages of the Recruiting Process, you will be requested to participate in a PEP Interview during which you will be asked to undergo a Polygraph Examination. The purpose of the PEP Interview and Examination is to assist in verifying your truthfulness, and in verifying that you are the person you claim to be in your employment application forms, questionnaires, and interviews.

**The RCMP is not looking for perfect people, but will recruit applicants who reflect the RCMP's core values, and who, in the RCMP's assessment, are the best qualified to serve Canadians as RCMP Regular Members.**

Your decision to complete the Applicant Questionnaire must be voluntary, based on your desire to pursue a career as a RCMP Regular Member.
