The Canadian Conference of the Arts presents the *Keith Kelly Award for Cultural Leadership* to a Canadian who has made a significant contribution to the arts through advocacy work or by playing a leading role in the development of public policy. The contribution recognized by the Award may range from local to international in scope.

Keith Kelly was the first recipient of the Award which was established as a lasting tribute to the spirited advocacy and dedicated leadership he exhibited during his tenure as National Director of the Canadian Conference of the Arts, 1989-98. The annual Award honours Canadians whose work on behalf of the arts reflects these leadership qualities.

The Awards Committee selects recipients from nominations submitted each year by the members of the CCA. Nominations must be received by the CCA **no later than April 30, 2005**. The Awards Ceremony will take place in November in conjunction with the CCA's 2005 National Policy Conference.
