

Sir Adolphe-Basil ROUTHIER (1839-1920) was a Quebec lawyer and poet commissioned by the Lieutenant Governor of Quebec to write the words for a song celebrating the "Congrès national des Canadiens-Français" in 1880. *O Canada* was the result. Routhier was appointed a judge in 1873, and was later Chief Justice of Quebec.
