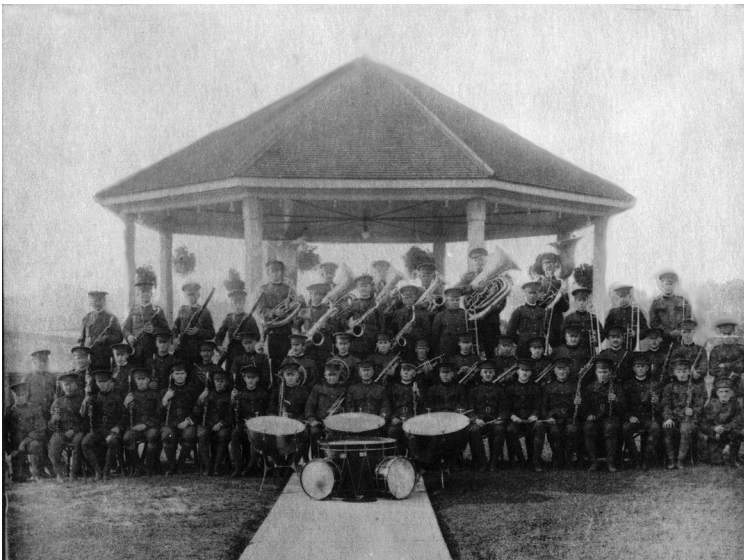




Band *SWEET MEMORIES WALTZ*

(BIOGRAPHY) HERBERT L. CLARKE (1867-1945) was born in Massachusetts but raised in Toronto where his father, William Horatio Clarke became organist at Jarvis Street Baptist Church in 1880. After playing in orchestras and bands, Herbert organized the Heintzman

Piano Company Band. When appearing as leading **cornetist** with the renowned **Gilmore Band** and later **Sousa's Band**, Clarke wrote *Sweet Memories Waltz* for piano around 1898. **(BACKGROUND)** While conductor of the Anglo-Canadian Leather Company Band in Huntsville, Ontario (1918-23) Clarke made this band arrangement. **(PUBLICATIONS)** New York, ET. Paull, 1898 (piano version); **CMH Music for Winds I: Bands** (band version). **(MUSIC)** This Waltz consists of an introduction, three waltzes in different keys, followed by a **coda**.
