




Knowledge of Official Languages among Visible Minorities, Canada 2001




Bilingualism by Age Group and Visible Minority - Canada 2001




Bilingualism of Visible Minorities Compared to Total Population - Canada, 2001




Bilingualism by Age Group and Visible Minority - Quebec 2001




Bilingualism of Visible Minorities Compared to Total Population - Quebec, 2001



Bilingualism by Age Group and Visible Minority – Canada less Quebec 2001






Bilingualism in Visible Minorities by Gender - Canada, 2001




Rate of Bilingualism among Visible Minorities by Gender



Bilingualism in Visible Minorities by Gender and Age Group - Canada, 2001




Rate of Bilingualism by type of Visible Minority – Canada, 2001


