2007-09-27- US has restricted imports of avian and avian products from Saskatchewan due to detection of highly pathogenic avian influenza (H7N3) in a poultry operation in that province. MRH 2009-01-26: Saturday Jan 24, Dr. Lord contacted the US and confirmed that only premises under restriction or epidemiologically linked to the index farm in BC were not eligible for export. MH 2011-FEBRUARY-16: Certificate amended to comply with new US rule banning vaccination for avian influenza with H5 or H7 and prohibiting transit thru an area where HPAI exists while on route to the US. US has advised that March 1, 2011 will be the implementation date however US border veterinarians have been requesting the change. MH
