I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the birds described below meet the following requirements:

1. The bird(s) originate from Canada and will be shipped by a direct route to Barbados.
2. There has been no outbreak of Newcastle disease, notifiable Avian Influenza or other infectious disease of commercial poultry in the past six (6) months within a fifty (50) kilometer radius of the quarantine premises from which the bird(s) originated.
3. The bird(s) have completed a thirty (30) day quarantine, supervised by a CFIA veterinarian, during which time there was no outbreak of infectious or contagious disease.
4. During the isolation period and within 2 weeks of export, the bird(s) have been subject to inspection by an official veterinarian and subjected to testing on a statistically significant number for Newcastle disease and Avian Influenza by PCR on nasal/cloacal swabs.
5. The birds have been treated for Chlamydiosis with a tetracycline for 45 days or have been tested for chlamydia by PCR with negative results within 7 days of export.
6. The birds have been treated for internal and external parasites within three (3) days of being exported with internationally approved formulations.
7. There has been no outbreak of contagious disease in the premises of origin during the period in which the birds were held and the birds were free from signs of contagious and infectious diseases.
8. All cages, crates, and vehicles used for transportation of the bird(s) were cleaned and disinfected in a manner approved by the CFIA.
9. The bird(s) were exported on the same day of release from the quarantine facility and did not come into contact with any domestic poultry or other caged birds during that time.
