I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the birds described below meet the following requirements:

- 1. The bird(s) have been hatched and raised or have been, for at least 30 days prior to the exportation, raised in the exporting country.
- 2. The exporting country have, for at least the past 2 years been free from HPAI. This period may be shortened for the exporting country which the Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries in Korea has recognized as practicing a stamping out policy, according to OIE standards.
- 3. In case of outbreaks of HPAI, the CFIA will halt the exportation of birds to Korea and at the same time provide Korea with details of all the relevant information as soon as possible and will consult with the Korean authorities regarding resumption of trade.
- 4. Birds commercially exported to Korea must be isolated and inspected in an embarkation quarantine facility approved by the CFIA for at least 21 days prior to shipment and during that time no evidence of infectious poultry disease presented.
- 5. The bird(s) were inspected by a CFIA veterinarian before exportation and found to be clinically healthy and free of infectious disease.
- 6. The bird(s) were exported directly to Korea and did not come into contact with any domestic poultry or other caged birds during that time. The birds were transported in new, clean containers or in containers that had been cleaned, disinfected and approved by CFIA. The birds were conveyed in a safe way to prevent the contamination with any agent of infectious poultry disease.
