I, the undersigned official veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the birds described below meet the following requirements:

1. The birds have been bred, born and raised in Canada or legally imported into Canada and resident in the country for 90 days.
2. Canada is officially recognized to be free from velogenic Newcastle disease and fowl typhoid.
3. The birds originate from areas or premises where there has been no incidence of Notifiable Avian Influenza, Newcastle Disease or any other serious communicable disease of poultry at the establishment of origin for the six months preceding export.
4. The birds have been quarantine for at least 30 days prior to export under the supervision of the CFIA and found to be free from clinical evidence of any infectious disease. During the quarantine period, the birds have been subjected to the following tests with negative results:  
  
Avian influenza virus serotypes H5 and H7 - PCR
5. The test sampling size is as follows:  
  

10 birds or less	100%
11-49 birds	15 birds
50-299 birds	20 birds
300 and more	30 birds
6. The birds have been examined by a CFIA veterinarian and found to be clinically healthy and free from signs of any infectious or contagious diseases prior to export.
7. The birds have not been in contact with or exposed to any bird suffering from any infectious disease within 30 days preceding the date of inspection, prior to export.
8. The birds have not been vaccinated with any vaccine that has not been approved.
