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I, the undersigned official veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and believ the bird described below meet the following requirements:

- 1. Canada is recognized to be free from Avian Ip denza
- 2. Canada is recognized to be free from velocities in Newcastle disease and fowl typhoid.
- 3. The birds have been resident in the castry of one in for a period of not less than 6 months or since hatching.
- 4. The birds have been kept in qualantic support the supervision of an authorized veterinarian for a period of 21 (twently one) days incrediately prior to shipment.
- 5. The birds have not been viscing equagainst Newcastle Disease or any disease.
- 6. In the case of fowls, ducks, tarkeys, pheasants, guinea fowl, partridges and quail, blood samples have been taken from all birds in the consignment after 10 (ten) days in quarantine and subjected to serological tests for Salmonella pullorum, Salmonella gallinarum and Salmonella typhimurium antibodies with negative results using test methods recommended by the OIE.
- 7. There has been no clinical signs or other evidence of Newcastle Disease, Fowl Cholera, Duck Viral Enteritis, Duck Viral Hepatitis, Mareks Disease, Avian Infectious Laryngotracheitis, Mycoplasma gallisepticum, Salmonellosis (including S.enteriditis, S.typhimurium, S.pullorum and S.gallinarum), Psittacosis, Infectious Bursal Disease, Avian Infectious Bronchitis, Avian Tuberculosis, including parasitism at the premises of origin during the 90 (ninety) days prior to export.

NOTE: Salmonellosis must be tested negative using bacterial culture.

8. The boxes or containers in which the birds are accomodated for export to Thailand should follow the IATA specifications particularily in relation to height, perch space and ventilation and with adequate access for feeding and watering.
