I, the undersigned official full-time salaried veterinary officer of the Government of Canada, hereby certify that following due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals identified below comply with the following requirements:

CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia.
2. Canada is recognized by the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) as a country with controlled bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) risk.
3. The herd of origin has been free of brucellosis and tuberculosis for the 12 months prior to export.
4. The animals were isolated for at least 21 days immediately prior to their movement for export.
5. The animals were inspected within 21 days prior to export and found to be free from clinical evidence of communicable diseases.
