I hereby certify that following due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals identified below comply with the following statements:

- The animals originate from Canada, or were legally imported into Canada and have been under no movement restrictions within Canada for at least 60 days prior to importation into the State of Qatar.
- 2 Canada is free of foot and mouth disease and peste des petits ruminants.
- The animals have been isolated for at least 30 days before departure on premises where only animals of the same 3. species have been kept. During the isolation period, they have been tested for the following diseases with negative results:
 - Bovine tuberculosis (Mycobacterium bovis) within sixty (60) days of export, each animal was tested with negative results using the single intradermal test at the post-axillary site.
 - Bovine brucellosis (Brucella abortus) BPAT or FPA
 - c) Bluetongue ELISA

Animals less than six (6) months of age and travelling at the foot of their dam are identified on this health certificate and meet the required health status, but were not tested for the above diseases.

- 4. Upon inspection prior to departure, the alpacas showed no clinical signs of communicable disease.
- The vehicles used for the transportation of the animals were cleaned and disinfected prior to the loading of the 5. animals
