I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief the animals identified below comply with the following:

- 1. The animals for export were born and raised in Canada.
- 2. On the date of departure, the animals were inspected and were found in good health and showed no clinical symptoms of disease including tuberculosis and brucellosis.
- 3. The animals for export showed no clinical signs of caprine arthritis encephalitis (CAE) on the day of shipment and those animals over one (1) year of age were test negative for CAE on an approved test performed within thirty (30) days prior to shipment.

OR

CAE was neither clinically nor serologically diagnosed on the farm of origin during the past three years.

- 4. The animals for export were transported in clean and disinfected vehicles directly to the point of departure without direct or indirect contact with animals which did not meet the same health requirements.
