

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animal described below complies with the following conditions:

- 1. The horse originates from Canada, a country which is free from African horse sickness (AHS), dourine, equine morbillivirus (Hendra virus), equine piroplasmosis, glanders, Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis and vesicular stomatitis.
- 2. Canada has been free from contagious equine metritis for a period of twenty (20) months immediately prior to embarkation.
- 3. During the one hundred eighty (180) days immediately prior to embarkation, the horse for export has not been boarded in any country where African Horse Sickness has occurred in the past two years immediately preceding the export.
- 4. During the two (2) years prior to embarkation, the horse for export has not been boarded in any country infected with contagious equine metritis.
- 5. The horse for export has been kept in isolation for a minimum of thirty (30) days in an establishment approved by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency and subjected to the following tests with negative results:
 - i) equine infectious anemia AGID (Coggins) test during the thirty (30) days prior to shipment;
 - ii) equine infectious abortion (*Salmonella abortus equi*) serum agglutination test (titre less than 1:3000) during the fifteen (15) days prior to shipment;
 - equine viral arteritis serum neutralization test on two occasions at least fourteen (14) days apart during the twenty eight (28) days prior to shipment.
- 6. The horse for export was vaccinated for equine influenza with the last vaccination being administered within thirty (30) days but not less that fourteen (14) days prior to embarkation.
- 7. The horse for export was kept in an establishment for three (3) months prior to shipment where no infectious or contagious disease, including equine encephalomyelitis, equine influenza, equine rhinopneumonitis, Potomac horse fever (equine monocytic ehrlichiosis), ulcerative lymphangitis, and West Nile Virus infection was reported.
- 8. The horse for export was kept in an establishment for three (3) months prior to shipment where no infectious or contagious disease, including dourine, epizootic lymphangitis, equine infectious anemia, equine piroplasmosis, trypanosomiasis, and vesicular stomatitis was reported and no such diseases were reported from an area within a 3 km radius of the establishment.
- The horse for export showed no clinical sign or symptom of infectious or contagious diseases on the day of shipment.
