I, the undersigned, being a duly authorized Veterinary Officer of the Government of Canada, hereby certify:

- 1. The horse has been in Canada during the sixty (60) days preceding export or since birth.
- 2. The horse has been inspected on the premises of origin and found free from evidence of communicable disease and external parasites and, insofar as can be determined, exposure thereto during the sixty (60) days preceding export.
- 3. The horse has not been vaccinated with a live, attenuated, or inactivated vaccine during the fourteen (14) days preceding export.
- 4. Insofar as can be determined, no case of equine ulcerative lymphangitis or vesicular stomatitis has occurred on the premises of origin or an adjoining premises during the sixty (60) days preceding export. Canada is free of African horse sickness, dourine, glanders, surra, epizootic lymphangitis, and Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis.
- 5. The horse tested negative to the immunodiffusion test or ELISA for equine infectious anemia within sixty (60) days preceding export.
- 6. The horse does not originate from a premises nor has it has been exposed to horses under quarantine for contagious equine metritis (CEM), and has not been in a country considered affected with CEM for the last twelve (12) months preceding export. Canada is free of CEM.
- 7. The horse has been vaccinated against Western and Eastern equine encephalomyelitis not less than fourteen (14) days and not more than one (1) year prior to the date of shipment.
- 8. The horse has been given a veterinary exam at the port of embarkation and found to be free from evidence of communicable disease and exposure thereto.
