



**VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, African horse sickness, dourine, glanders, piroplasmiasis, vesicular stomatitis, contagious equine metritis and Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis.
2. The animals destined for export were born and bred in Canada or have been resident in Canada for the preceding twelve (12) months.
3. No case of dourine (Mal du coit), Mal de Caderas, glanders, (Farcy), epizootic lymphangitis, ulcerative lymphangitis, equine viral arteritis, equine influenza, equine infectious anemia, equine rhinopneumonitis, contagious equine metritis, equine encephalomyelitis or mange occurred on premises where the animals were kept for at least sixty (60) days prior to exportation.
4. The animals have been immunized against the following diseases:
 - i) equine influenza using an inactivated multistrain vaccine (A1 and A2) within three (3) months of exportation.
 - ii) equine rhinopneumonitis using an inactivated vaccine given two (2) doses thirty (30) days apart within sixty (60) days of exportation.
5. The animals have been isolated on a premises approved by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency for at least thirty (30) days prior to their departure.
6. The animals have been subjected to the following tests with negative results within thirty (30) days of departure:
 - i) equine infectious anemia - agar gel immunodiffusion test (Coggins)
 - ii) equine viral arteritis - complement fixation test or serum neutralization (SNT)
7. The animals were examined prior to departure and found to be healthy and free of clinical evidence of infectious diseases.
