I hereby certify, in respect of the animals described below, that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief:

- The animals have been in Canada and/or the U.S.A. during the sixty (60) days preceding exportation. 1
- The animals were inspected on the premises of origin and found free from evidence of communicable disease and, insofar as can 2 be determined, have not been exposed to communicable disease during the sixty (60) days preceding exportation.
- The animals have not been vaccinated with a live or attenuated or inactivated vaccine during the fourteen (14) days preceding 3. exportation.
- Insofar as can be determined, no case of African horse sickness, dourine, glanders, surra, epizootic lymphangitis, ulcerative 4. lymphangitis, equine piroplasmosis, equine infectious anemia, vesicular stomatitis, contagious equine metritis or Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis has occurred on the premises of origin or on adjoining premises during the sixty (60) days preceding exportation.
- During the one hundred and eighty (180) days preceding exportation, the animals were tested for equine infectious anemia using 5. the immunodiffusion test (Coggins) or ELISA test and the results were negative.
- The animals have not been in a country considered affected with contagious equine metritis (C.E.M) during the twelve (12) 6. months immediately prior to its exportation, except for horses of United States origin which have met Canadian import requirements for C.E.M.
