- (b) It has been examined today and shows no clinical sign of disease (2).
- (c) It is not intended for slaughter under a national program of infectious or contagious disease eradication.
- (d) During the last 40 days immediately preceding the exportation it has been resident on holdings under veterinary supervision in:
  - the country of dispatch, and/or
  - Member States of the Community, and/or
  - United Arab Emirates, Australia, Belarus, Canada, Switzerland, Greenland, Hong-Kong, Croatia, Iceland, Japan, Republic of Korea, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Macao, Malaysia (peninsula), Norway, New Zealand, Russia <sup>(1)</sup>, Singapore, Thailand, Ukraine, United States of America, Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.
