- 6. The dogs or wolves to be exported were clinically examined by the approved veterinarian within twenty-four (24) hours of export and found to be apparently healthy and free from any sign of infectious or contagious diseases.
- 7. Feeds and bedding used during quarantine and transportation were from areas free of epizootic disease and meet the veterinary quarantine conditions.
- 8. During quarantine and transportation, the dogs or wolves exported were not in contact with animals not certified for export to China and were not transported through areas where serious epizootic diseases exist.

- 9. All crates, vehicles, ships or aircraft used to transport the dogs or wolves to China were cleaned and disinfected with an effective disinfectant approved by the Government of Canada.
- 10. If applicable, individual pet dogs accompanied by their owners, except for guide dogs, have met the following requirements:
  - a) have been vaccinated at least fourteen (14) days and not more than thirty (30) days before export with vaccines as described in Section 2 above;
  - b) have been treated with parasiticide as described in Section 5 above;
  - c) have been clinically examined as described in Section 6 above;
  - d) have crates disinfected as described in Section 9 above.
