I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian duly authorized by the Government of Canada, certify after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, that:

1. The exported animals originate from Canada, a country free of bovine tuberculosis in livestock.
2. The farm of origin has been free from B-virus infection, tuberculosis, salmonellosis and shigellosis for the past 12 months.
3. The animals have been kept in quarantine for at least 30 days on a premises approved by an official veterinarian of the exporting country.
4. During the quarantine period, the animals were tested with negative result for the following diseases:
 - 4.1 Tuberculosis: intradermal test (bovine and human tuberculin)
 - 4.2 Salmonellosis: fecal swab for appropriate bacteriologic examination
 - 4.3 Shigellosis: fecal swab for appropriate bacteriologic examination
 - 4.4 B-virus: ELISA or PCR
5. During the quarantine period, the animals were treated under the supervision of an official veterinarian of the exporting country, against internal and external parasites with effective parasiticides.
6. Prior to shipment, the non-human primates for export were clinically examined and were found healthy, free from signs of contagious diseases, and fit to travel.
