

VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE EXPORT OF SWINE TO ST-VINCENT, WEST INDIES

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals described below comply with the following requirements:

- 1. The animals originate from Canada, a country which is officially free of foot and mouth disease, vesicular stomatitis, swine vesicular disease, vesicular exanthema, African swine fever, classical swine fever, brucellosis and pseudorabies and has been free for the twenty-four (24) month period preceding the shipment.
- 2. The animals are not more than two (2) years of age.
- 3. The animals were placed, for a minimum period of thirty (30) days and until the date of shipment, in a quarantine premises approved by the CFIA.
- 4. The animals were vaccinated against erysipelas within the ninety (90) days preceding shipment.
- 5. The animals were treated against external parasites seven (7) days prior to shipment.
- 6. The animals for export were inspected before shipment and were considered physically sound and healthy, free from symptoms of viral pneumonia, atrophic rhinitis and other infectious or contagious diseases and free of external parasites.
- 7. The animals are not transported with animals from an other country during their transport to St-Vincent.
