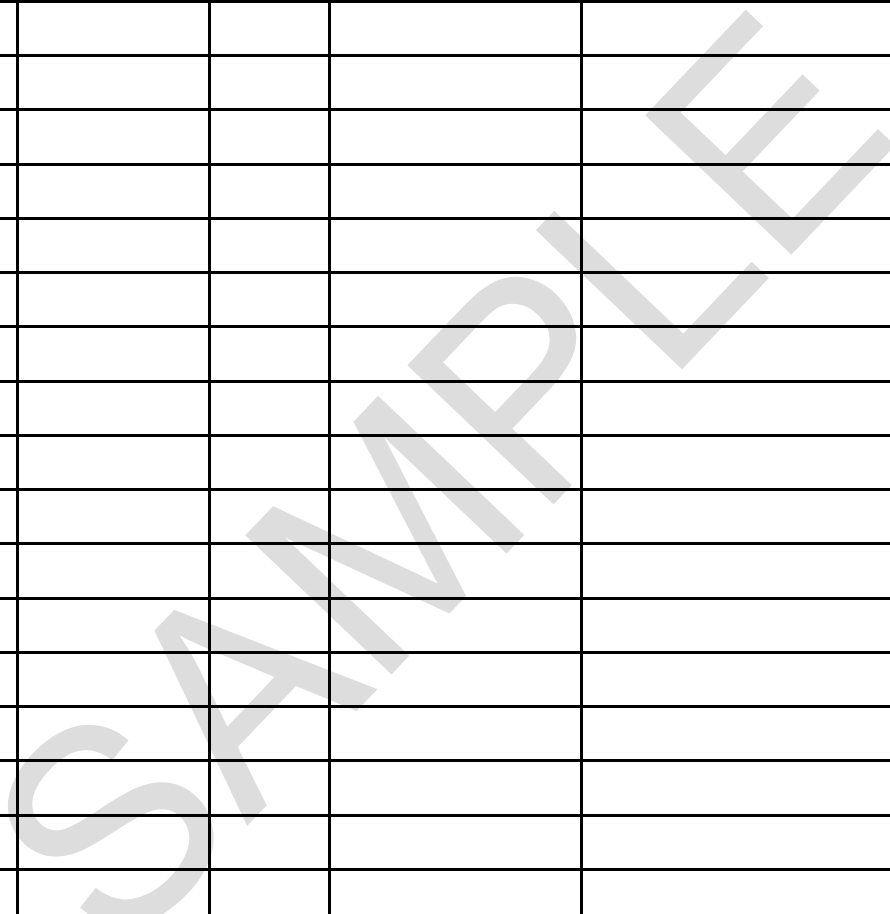
SECTION II - Health attestation

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, vesicular stomatitis, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, classical swine fever (hog cholera), Aujeszky's disease and Teschen disease.
2. The animals for export were born and raised in Canada.
3. The animals for export originate from herds officially free tuberculosis (*Mycobacterium bovis*) and brucellosis.
4. The animals for export originate from herds known to be free from transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) and swine influenza during the twelve (12) months prior to embarkation.
5. The animals for export originate from herds in which no clinical cases of leptospirosis occurred in the ninety days (90) days prior to embarkation.
6. The animals for export were isolated either on the farms of origin or in an assembly point for a minimum of twenty-one (21) days immediately preceding embarkation.
7. During the isolation period the animals for export were tested for the following diseases with negative results:
 - a) PRRS - ELISA test
