 - b) have been prepared and stored in a dedicated fish plant approved, validated and supervised by the competent authority;
 - c) are packed in new containers or in containers that have been cleaned and all precautions taken to prevent their contamination;
 - d) were clinically healthy on the day of harvest and have been transported under conditions that do not alter the animal health status of the product;
 - e) bear the labels indicating “NOT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION”.
