I, the undersigned, duly authorized Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) do hereby certify that:

1. The semen was collected from a donor bull maintained at an artificial insemination (A.I.) centre approved or licensed by the Government of Canada.
2. The semen was collected and processed under strict hygienic conditions, under the supervision of an authorized veterinarian.
3. No unsterilized substance, other than egg yolk, was added to the semen diluent.
4. Based on Canadian standards, the semen is free from pathogenic organisms.
5. The donor bull and all other sires kept at the A.I. centre have been:
  - a) tested with negative results for tuberculosis, brucellosis, leptospirosis, paratuberculosis, bluetongue, bovine leucosis, campylobacteriosis and trichomoniasis;
  - b) free from clinical evidence of Q fever, Chlamydiosis, fibropapillomas, bovine virus diarrhoea, parainfluenza 3 and infectious pustular vulvovaginitis.
6. Canada is free from foot and mouth disease and contagious bovine pleuropneumonia.

The document Form V in page 3 must be completed by the CFIA district office issuing the certificate as required by the Veterinary Authorities in Pakistan to facilitate entry of the semen at the border.
