SECTION III

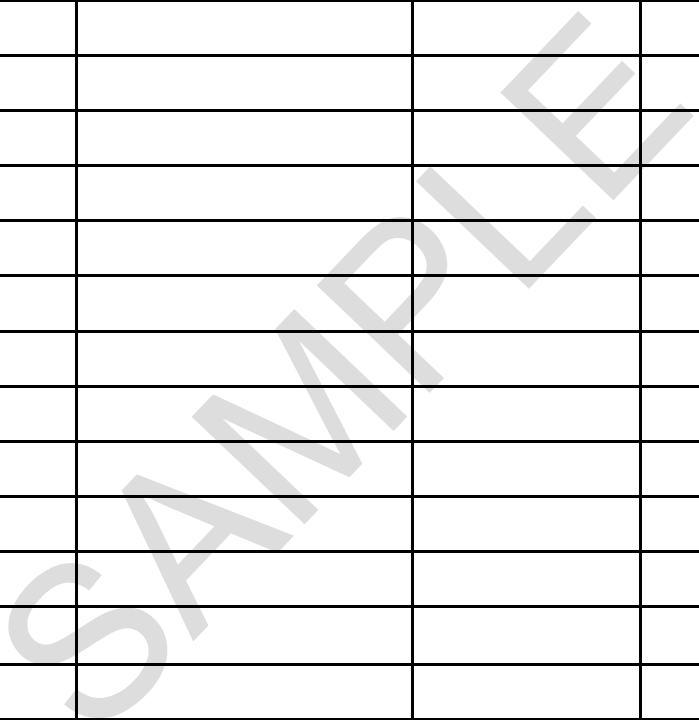
I, the undersigned official veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that:

1. Canada is free from foot and mouth disease, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, lumpy skin disease, Rift Valley fever and rinderpest.
2. The semen was collected from a bull maintained in an artificial insemination centre which is under official veterinary control. The donor bull has been housed at the centre for at least six (6) months prior to collection of the semen for export to Indonesia.
3. The donor bulls were healthy and free from any clinical evidence of infectious diseases at the time of collection of the semen.
4. The donor bulls and all other cattle in the AI centre were born and raised in Canada or the USA and since entering the AI centre have not been used for natural service.
5. All of the animals maintained at the AI centre, including the donor bull, are recognized to be free of tuberculosis, brucellosis, leptospirosis, paratuberculosis, bluetongue, enzootic bovine leucosis, campylobacteriosis and trichomoniasis, and are clinically free from bovine malignant catarrhal fever, IBR, blackleg, anthrax, Q-fever and BVD.
6. All donor animals at the centre are tested negative for the following diseases at six (6) month intervals:
 - 6.1. brucellosis - complement fixation test (CF) or ELISA;
 - 6.2. leptospirosis - microagglutination lysis test;
 - 6.3. bluetongue - complement fixation test or agar gel immunodiffusion test or ELISA;
 and for the following diseases at twelve (12) month intervals:
 - 6.4. paratuberculosis - complement fixation test or ELISA;
 - 6.5. leucosis - agar gel immunodiffusion test (AGID) or ELISA;
 - 6.6. tuberculosis - intradermal tuberculin test;
 - 6.7. campylobacteriosis - culture test;
 - 6.8. trichomoniasis - direct microscopic examination.
7. The semen is shipped in a container that is new or has been cleaned and disinfected and has been stored separately from other semen not of the same status in fresh liquid nitrogen and sterilized flasks. The container has been sealed by a CFIA veterinarian prior to shipment.
8. The semen was collected, processed and stored in accordance with Certified Semen Services (CSS) or international standards.
9. The semen was treated with antibiotics effective against *Leptospira* and *Mycoplasma* spp.
10. The semen has been stored frozen for the last 28 days.
