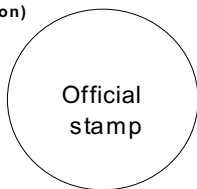

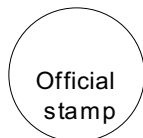

I, the undersigned, **Official Veterinarian**, hereby certify that ⁽²⁾:

- A the above-listed products are being exported from a country or zone specified at Appendix IV and meet any requirements which may be set forth in Column 4 of Appendix IV;
- B the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:
 - 1) have undergone the ad hoc treatments specified at Appendix I for inactivating the pathogens of foot-and-mouth disease (FMD), rinderpest, bovine tuberculosis, classical swine fever (CSF), African swine fever (ASF), swine vesicular disease (SVD), enterovirus encephalomyelitis, porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome, trichinellosis, Aujeszky's disease and swine cysticercosis; or
 - 2) meet the following requirements;
- C the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials are entirely derived from animals which have passed ante-mortem and post-mortem inspections, especially for foot-and-mouth disease, anthrax, bovine tuberculosis, classical swine fever, African swine fever, swine vesicular disease, enterovirus encephalomyelitis, trichinellosis;
- D the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:
 - 1) are entirely derived from animals that, from birth or not less than 3 months up to and including slaughter, have stayed in and travelled through only countries or zones:
 - a) specified in Appendix IV; and
 - b) that were not subject to any bans (at the time the animals were staying in or travelling through such countries or zones) as specified at Appendix IV Column 3; and
 - c) that were (at the time the animals were staying in or travelling through such countries or zones) **FMD-free where vaccination is not practised**, rinderpest infection free, CSF-free in domestic and wild pigs or free of CSF in domestic pigs but with infection in the wild pig population, ASF free, SVD free and enterovirus encephalomyelitis free; and
 - d) in which no case of foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, classical swine fever, African swine fever, swine vesicular disease or enterovirus encephalomyelitis appeared:
 - i) up until this certificate was issued; or
 - ii) within three months after the animals stayed in or travelled through or were slaughtered in such countries or zones; and
 - 2) are entirely derived from animals that, from birth or no fewer than 40 days prior to and including slaughter, have always remained at a distance of not less than 10 km away from any case of foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest; classical swine fever, African swine fever, vesicular swine disease or enterovirus encephalomyelitis;
- E the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials are entirely derived from animals reared in establishments located in a country or zone that is historically free from porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome;
- F the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:
 - 1) have been entirely derived from animals that, from birth up to and including slaughter, have lived only in countries or zones that are free from trichinellosis in domestic swine; or
 - 2) have undergone testing for trichinellosis using the peptic digestion method and produced negative results;
- G the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials:
 - 1) are entirely derived from animals reared in establishments located in a country or zone that is free from Aujeszky's disease; or
 - 2) do not contain any offal (head, thoracic and abdominal viscera);
- H the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials are entirely derived from animals only reared in establishments that have not been subject to any ban due to anthrax and in which:
 - 1) no case of anthrax appeared 20 days prior to slaughter; and
 - 2) no vaccination against anthrax has been administered within a period of 42 days prior to slaughter;
- I the above-listed products or their constituents or raw materials are entirely derived from animals that have undergone a post-mortem inspection for swine cysticercosis and have been found to be free of swine cysticercosis;
