



# Moving Firewood?

**You could be transporting quarantine pests.**

The movement of firewood from pest-regulated areas of Canada is strictly controlled. Firewood is known to carry **insects** and **plant diseases** that could spread to other uninfested areas of Canada.

If you move firewood, possibly when camping, relocating or managing a wood lot, you could be transporting one of the following quarantine pests:

- **Asian Long-horned Beetle\***
- **Brown Spruce Longhorn Beetle**
- **Emerald Ash Borer**
- **European Larch Canker**
- **Dutch Elm Disease**
- **Gypsy Moth**
- **Pine Shoot Beetle**
