I, the undersigned official veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the birds described below meet the following requirements:

1. The bird(s) originate from Canada, a country free of Notifiable Avian Influenza and Viscerotropic Velogenic Newcastle Disease. The birds have been born, raised or remained in Canada for a minimum of 30 days prior to the date of shipment.
2. The birds originated from a premises where there has been no evidence of the following diseases for the year prior to the date of shipment:

Avian cholera, Chamydia psittaci (psittacosis), Mycoplasmosis (*M.gallisepticum*), Avian salmonellosis (*S. enteritidis* or *S. typhimurium*) Avian tuberculosis and fowl pox.
3. The birds have been kept under observation in the facility of origin, isolated from other birds and under official supervision for a period of 30 days prior to the shipment results.
4. The birds have not been administered any immunogen prior to the shipment date.
5. The owner must provide a notarized declaration to the veterinarian endorsing the certificate that states the bird has been in the owner's possession for 90 days prior to shipment.
6. The cages or boxes used for transport are new and made of wood or cardboard so that they can be destroyed upon arrival in Panama.
7. During the observation and isolation period, the birds have been treated for endoparasites and ectoparasites with products authorized by the country of origin.

8. The birds have been inspected at the time of shipment from the facility of origin by an official veterinarian and there are no signs of tumours, fresh or healing lesions and no signs of transmittable infectious or contagious diseases or ectoparasites.
