I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the sheep and/or goats described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, peste de petits ruminants, vesicular stomatitis, bluetongue, brucellosis and Rift Valley fever and has been free for the twenty-four (24) month period preceding the shipment.
2. As far as has can de determined, scrapie has not existed on the premises of origin of the animals during the three (3) years immediately prior to the date of shipment and the animals are not the progeny of a sire or dam which has been affected by scrapie.
3. The animals were subjected to tests for the following diseases within thirty (30) days prior to shipment, with negative results:
 - i) tuberculosis - caudal intradermal tuberculin test;
 - ii) brucellosis - Buffered Plate Antigen Test (BPAT).
4. The animals were vaccinated against tetanus.
5. The animals were treated against external parasites seven (7) days prior to shipment.
6. The animals for export were inspected before shipment and were considered physically sound and healthy, free from symptoms of infectious or contagious diseases, including scrapie, and free of external parasites.
