



**VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, that the animals described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, sheep and goat pox, Rift Valley fever, peste des petits ruminants, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, lumpy skin disease, and caprine and ovine brucellosis (*B. melitensis*). Vaccination against these diseases is not permitted.
2. The animals originate from herds which have been free of bovine tuberculosis, contagious agalactia, scrapie and anthrax for the last six (6) months.
3. The animals originate from farms/premises in which no clinical case of caprine arthritis/encephalitis (goats only) or maedi-visna (sheep only) has been diagnosed during the last three (3) years and in which no clinical sign of enzootic abortion of ewes, salmonella abortusovis, leptospirosis, melioidosis and paratuberculosis have been observed in the previous six (6) months.
4. The animals have obtained a negative result to a serological test for the following diseases within thirty (30) days of departure.
 - a) bluetongue
 - b) caprine arthritis/encephalitis (goats only) or maedi-visna (sheep only)
5. The animals were examined prior to departure and found free of evidence of infectious or contagious diseases.
6. Regulations prohibiting the feeding of meat and bone meal derived from ruminants to ruminants have been enacted in Canada on August 4, 1997. These regulations include provisions for enforcement.
7. The animals were treated against internal and external parasites with approved products within thirty (30) days of departure.
8. The animals were transported in clean vehicles to the point of embarkation without coming into contact with animals of lesser health status.
