4.	The collection, treatment, prepa	ration and storage of the embryos was performed in premises set aside for that					

- 4. The collection, treatment, preparation and storage of the embryos was performed in premises set aside for that purpose, under hygiene conditions that meet the criteria established in the Terrestrial Animal Healh Code from the OIE and the International Embryo Transfer Society.
- 5. Each lot of embryos was prepared, frozen and placed inside sterile containers. The straws which contain the embryos and the containers are marked in such a way as to identify the date of collection, the male and female donor animals and the approval number of the collection team.
- 6. The embryos were collected, prepared and stored in embryo transfer equipment approved by the competent authority of the country of origin with regard to the rules of hygiene governing those operations.
- 7. The embryo collection team has specific premises and materials for the operation to prepare the embryos and those operations are inspected by the official veterinary service at least once a year.
- 8. The collection team is subject to quality control by an official veterinarian of the country of origin, at least once a year.
- 9. The embryos were frozen and stored in a place approved by the competent authority of the country of origin for a minimum of 30 days prior to export.
- 10. The female donors were born in the counry of origin.
- 11. The donor females remained for at least six months in a herd that is officially free from bovine tuberculosis.
- 12. The herd is free of brucellosis (Brucella spp).
- 13. The embryo collection centre is free of tuberculosis.

- 14. At the time of collection of the embryos, the donor females were found free of clinical signs of the following diseases: bluetongue, *Campylobacter fetus*, foot and mouth disease, scrapie, akabane, maedi-visna, pulmonary adenomatosis, *Brucella ovis* and border disease.
- 15. Concerning scrapie or lumbar prurigo, that:
  - 15.1 the disease is mandatorily notifiable; and
  - 15.2 Canada maintains active and passive surveillance for scrapie in support of an eradication program for the disease; and
  - 15.3 all ovines and caprines affected by the disease are slaughtered and competely destroyed; and
  - 15.4 the donor animal was born and stayed in an establishment free of scrapie or lumbar prurigo during five years prior to the collection of the semen, embryos and/or ovocytes; and
  - 15.5 the parents (male and female) of the donor did not die because of scrapie or lumbar prurigo or did not present clinical evidence of scrapie or lumbar prurigo.
- 16. The donor did not present clinical evidence of scrapie or lumbar prurigo.
- 17. The donors were kept since their birth in premises where no positive cases of scrapie or lumbar prurigo were confirmed during their stay; ref: Chapter 2.4.8, Art. 2.4.8.9 of the OIE.
