## **SANITARY INFORMATION:**

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, that:

- 1. The female donors were born in Canada.
- 2. The flock of origin is free of brucellosis (Brucella spp).
- 3. The embryo collection centre is free of tuberculosis.
- 4. At the time of the collection of the embryos, the donor females were found free of clinical signs of the following diseases: bluetongue, *Campylobacter fetus*, foot-and-mouth disease, scrapie, maedi-visna, pulmonary adenomatosis, *Brucella ovis* and border disease.
- 5. At the time of collection, the donors animals were in good health.
- 6. The donor animals did not present any clinical evidence of scrapie (lumbar prurigo).
- 7. The donors were kept since their birth in premises where no positive cases of scrapie (lumbar prurigo) were confirmed during their stay.
- 8. When a natural service or fresh semen was used, the male donors complied with the same sanitary requirements as the female donors.
- The collection, treatment, preparation and storage of the embryos were performed in premises set aside for that
  purpose, under hygienic conditions that met the criteria established in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of the OIE
  and the International Embryo Transfer Society.
- 10. Each lot of embryos was prepared, frozen and placed inside sterile containers. The straws which contain the embryos and the containers are marked in such a way as to identify the date of collection, the male and female donor animals, and the approval number of the collection team.
- 11 The straws containing the embryos are marked with the identification number of the donor animals
- 12. The embryos were collected, prepared and stored in embryo transfer equipment approved by the competent authority of the country of origin with regard to the rules of hygiene governing those operations.

- 13. The embryo collection team has specific premises and materials for the operation to prepare the embryos and those operations are inspected by the official veterinary service at least once a year.
- 14. The embryos were frozen and stored in a place approved by the competent authority of the country of origin for 30 days prior to export.
