I, the undersigned, being an Official Veterinarian designated by the competent central authority of Canada, certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, dourine, glanders and contagious equine metritis.
2. As far as can be ascertained no case of dourine, mal de Carderas, glanders, epizootic lymphangitis, ulcerative lymphangitis, equine influenza, equine infectious anemia, contagious equine metritis, equine encephalomyelitis or Mange occurred on the premises or within a radius of fifteen (15) miles of where the animal(s) were kept for at least the thirty (30) days immediately prior to the date of exportation.
3. The animal(s) has/have been vaccinated against Eastern and Western Equine Encephalomyelitis not less than thirty (30) days and not more than six (6) months prior to the date of shipment;

4. Within thirty (30) days of shipment, the animal(s) has/have been subjected to testing for equine infectious anemia with negative results as determined by the use of the immunodiffusion test (Coggin's test) in a laboratory approved for that purpose by the Government of Canada.
