I, the undersigned Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada do certify that:

1. The swine originate from herds where no clinical evidence of reportable disease has existed for at least thirty (30) days prior to shipment.
2. The herd of origin is free from clinical signs of anthrax, pasteurellosis, atrophic rhinitis, enzootic pneumonia, transmissible gastroenteritis and S.M.E.D.I. virus.
3. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, classical swine fever, Aujeszky's disease, African swine fever, swine vesicular disease, vesicular exanthema, Teschen disease and Hog Cholera..
4. The animals for export were subjected to the following tests with negative results within thirty (30) days prior to export:
 - a) tuberculosis - intradermal tuberculin test;
 - b) atrophic rhinitis - nasal culture.
 - c) mycoplasmosis - ELISA
5. Leptospirosis - the swine were treated with an antibiotic that is efficacious in the treatment of leptospirosis at the manufactures recommended dosage.
