

1.	<p>On June 3rd at page 53, line 12 of the transcript (attached), Mr Rosenbloom asked you about the three habitat status reports referred to in exhibit 962, slide 5 (exhibit 962 attached).</p> <p>My question of you, Mr. Saunders, is, having regard to the purpose of exhibit 962, specifically as set out on slide 2 bullet 1 that is to provide an update on 2010-11 WSP implementation, are the three completed habitat status reports listed in slide 5 bullet 2 the only completed habitat status reports ever completed, or only those done in 2010-11?</p>

	<p>Mark Saunders:</p> <p>“My response is as follows. I understand that there have been six habitat status reports undertaken that include the three noted in the powerpoint presentation. The additional three are Lower Harrison, Sarita and Cowichan/Koksilah.”</p>
