I would like to change my answer to 8d to the following:

The provisional lower benchmark is more precautionary than recovery objectives 1-3. The recovery strategy did not set a target reference point for Objective 4 so it is not possible to assess. It is important to remember that the WSP benchmarks are not limit reference points.

I have attached the draft document that was provided at the CSAP review meeting and two tables that have been revised. Ms Grant will be able to provide the revised document when she returns from leave in 1.5 weeks.
