Mr. Crey is from the Cheam community, east of Chilliwack, and is a member of the Stó:lō Nation. Mr. Crey worked for DFO as an Aboriginal Advisor from 1984-1990, after which he was hired to manage the fisheries program for the Stó:lō Tribal Council.

His current role is Fisheries and Policy Advisor for the Stó:lō Tribal Council, and his involvement in fisheries-related processes includes:

- Member, Fraser River Aboriginal Fisheries Secretariat (FRAFS), Executive Committee
- Member, Fraser Valley Aboriginal Fisheries Society (FVAFS)
- Alternate Member, Monitoring and Compliance Panel, Integrated Salmon Dialogue Forum (ISDF)

Mr. Crey also served as a member of the Pacific Salmon Commission's Fraser River Panel for four years in the early 1990s.
