HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 58, A3.3-15-1:

1). Spleen, capsule: Serositis, mild to moderate, multifocal, granulomatous, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 59, A3.3-15-2:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 60, A3.3-15-3:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 61, A3.3-15-4:

1). Spleen, capsule: Serositis, mild, multifocal, granulomatous, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 62, A3.3-15-5:

There are no overt lesions within the pyloric caecae, adipose tissue, pancreas, spleen, liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 63, A3.3-15-6:

1). Heart, spongy layer: Myocarditis, mild, focal, necrotising, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, pancreas, spleen, liver or kidney.

Slide 64, A3.3-15-7:

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, pancreas, spleen, liver, kidney or heart.

Slide 65, A3.3-15-8:

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, liver, kidney or heart.

COMMENTS:

There are no significant lesions within the examined sections. The peritonitis noted in 2 sections is consistent with post vaccination and the myocarditis noted in 1 section is chronic and low grade.
