MORPHOLOGIC DIAGNOSES:

Slide 101, A2.3-32-1:

1). Spleen and adipose tissue: Peritonitis, moderate, focally extensive, granulomatous, chronic with mesothelial hyperplasia and hypertrophy

There are no overt lesions within the kidney, liver, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 102, A2.3-32-2:

1). Spleen: Congestion and hyperemia, moderate, diffuse, acute

There are no overt lesions within the kidney, liver, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature.

Slide 103, A2.3-32-3:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, kidney, liver, heart, peripheral nerves or peripheral vasculature

COMMENTS:

There are no significant lesions within any of the examined tissues; the splenic congestion and hyperemia is considered an agonal or terminal phenomenon and the peritoneal infiltrate is consistent with resolving vaccine induced peritonitis that would not have contributed significantly to antemortem morbidity.
