HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 61, A3.1-27-1:

1). Liver, sinusoids: Fibrin deposition, moderate, multifocal, random, acute

There are no significant lesions within the kidney, heart, spleen or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

The sinusoidal fibrin deposition is suggestive of disseminated intravascular coagulation. The precise pathogenesis or etiology of this condition is unknown; however, generalized septicemia (consumptive coagulopathy) is a prime consideration. If fresh tissue is available, follow up bacterial and possible viral culture may be undertaken.
