MORPHOLOGIC DIAGNOSES:

Slide 74, A2.4-12-1:

1). Spleen: Congestion and hyperemia, moderate, diffuse, acute

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, liver, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

Slide 75, A2.4-12-2:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

Slide 76, A2.4-12-3:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

Slide 77, A2.4-12-4:

1). Liver: Hepatitis, mild, multifocal, lymphocytic, chronic

There are no overt lesions within the pancreas, spleen, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

Slide 78, A2.4-12-5:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

Slide 79, A2.4-12-6:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, liver, kidney, heart, peripheral nerves and peripheral vasculature.

COMMENTS:

There are no overt lesions within the examined sections which may adversely effect growth performance or productivity. The lymphocytic hepatitis noted in slide 77 is low grade, non-specific and would not have contributed significantly to impaired hepatic function.
