HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 48, P3-47-1:

There are no significant lesions within the peripheral vasculature, heart, liver, anterior kidney, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 49, P3-47-2:

1). Liver: Hepatitis, minimal, focal, lymphocytic, chronic

There are no significant lesions within the pancreas, heart, posterior kidney, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 50, P3-47-3:

There are no significant lesions within the peripheral vasculature, heart, liver, kidney, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 51, P3-47-4:

There are no significant lesions within the heart, liver, kidney, peripheral vasculature, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 52, P3-47-5:

There are no significant lesions within the liver, heart, peripheral vasculature, kidney, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 53, P3-47-6:

There are no significant lesions within the liver, posterior kidney, spleen, peripheral vasculature, heart, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 54, P3-47-7:

There are no significant lesions within the liver, heart, peripheral vasculature, kidney, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

There are no significant lesions within any of the examined slides; the hepatitis noted in slide 49 is chronic low grade and an incidental finding.
