HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 33, P3-48-1:

Aside from marked post mortem change, there are no significant lesions within the heart, posterior kidney, peripheral vasculature, spleen, liver, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 34, P3-48-2:

1). Heart, endocardium: Hyperplasia, mild, multifocal, random

There are no significant lesions within the posterior kidney, peripheral vasculature, pancreas, spleen, liver, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 35, P3-48-3:

There are no significant lesions within the heart, posterior kidney, peripheral vasculature, pancreas, spleen, liver, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 36, P3-48-4:

There are no significant lesions within the heart, liver, kidney, peripheral vasculature, brain, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 37, P3-48-5:

There are no significant lesions within the heart, liver, kidney, peripheral vasculature, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 38, P3-48-6:

There are no significant lesions within the kidney, peripheral vasculature, heart, liver, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 39, P3-48-7:

1). Kidney: Nephrocalcinosis, mild, multifocal, chronic

There are no significant lesions within the peripheral vasculature, heart, liver, spleen, or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

The endocardial hyperplasia noted in slide 34 and nephrocalcinosis in slide 39 are considered incidental findings of limited pathologic significance. There are no overt lesions within the examined tissues which may adversely impact the growth or performance of the sampled stock.
