HISTOPATHOLOGY:

Slide 75, P3-49-1:

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, liver, peripheral nerve, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

Slide 76, P3-49-2:

There are no overt lesions within the peripheral nerve, spleen, heart, liver, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

Slide 77, P3-49-3:

1). Peripheral vasculature, liver: Vasculitis, moderate, multifocal, transmural, subacute

There are no overt lesions within the liver, heart, peripheral nerve, adipose tissue, spleen, or kidney.

Slide 78, P3-49-4:

There are no overt lesions within the spleen, heart, peripheral nerve, liver, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

Slide 79, P3-49-5:

There are no overt lesions within the peripheral nerve, spleen, heart, liver, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

Slide 80, P3-49-6:

1). Spleen, capsule: Peritonitis, moderate, diffuse, lymphohistiocytic and fibrinous, subacute with florid intralesional coccobacilli

2). Heart, endocardium: Hyperplasia and hypertrophy, mild, multifocal, subacute

There are no overt lesions within the adipose tissue, liver, peripheral nerve, peripheral vasculature or kidney.

COMMENTS:

With the exception of slide 77 and 80, there are no significant microscopic disease processes within the examined tissues; the intralesional bacilli noted in slide 80 are suggestive of *Renibacterium salmoninarum* and follow up culture and ancillary studies may be considered. In slide 77, the transmural vasculature likely represents a sequela to septicemia or bacteremia.
