MORPHOLOGIC DIAGNOSES:

Slide 30, A3.1-22-1:

1). Liver, capsule: Peritonitis, mild, diffuse, fibrinous, chronic

There are no significant lesions in the kidney, heart, spleen, peripheral vasculature, adipose tissue, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 31, A3.1-22-2:

1). Liver, capsule: Peritonitis, mild, diffuse, fibrinous, chronic

There are no significant lesions in the pancreas, adipose tissue, kidney, heart, spleen, peripheral vasculature, or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

The peritonitis noted in both sections is low grade, chronic and non-specific; this process may represent either post vaccination or an infectious etiology. If fresh tissue is available, follow up special culture or PCR may be considered.
