MORPHOLOGIC DIAGNOSES:

Slide 25, P2-22-1:

1). Heart, endocardium: Hyperplasia, mild, multifocal, random

There are no significant lesions in the kidney, inter-renal tissue, liver, spleen, peripheral vasculature, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 26, P2-22-2:

There are no significant lesions in the kidney, heart, liver, spleen, peripheral vasculature, or peripheral nerves.

Slide 27, P2-22-3:

There are no significant lesions in the kidney, liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature, or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

The endocardial hyperplasia noted in slide 25 is consistent with low grade, persistent antigenemia which likely would not have contributed significantly to antemortem morbidity; there were no other significant lesions within the examined tissues. Should stock exhibit increased morbidity, viral and bacterial culture is recommended.
