MORPHOLOGIC DIAGNOSES:

Slide 1, P3-35-1:

There are no significant lesions in the anterior kidney, liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

Slide 2, P3-35-2:

There are no significant lesions in the anterior kidney, liver, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

Slide 3, P3-35-3:

1). Kidney: Nephrocalcinosis, moderate, multifocal to coalescing, subacute

There are no significant lesions in the liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

Slide 4, P3-35-4:

1). Kidney: Nephrocalcinosis, mil to moderate, diffuse, acute

There are no significant lesions in the liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

Slide 5, P3-35-5:

There are no significant lesions in the anterior kidney, liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

Slide 6, P3-35-6:

There are no significant lesions in the anterior kidney, liver, spleen, heart, peripheral vasculature or peripheral nerves.

COMMENTS:

There are no significant lesions within the examined tissues; the nephrocalcinosis noted in 2 of 6 sections is low grade and of limited pathologic significance. This condition has been associated with increased ambient carbon dioxide levels, excessive dietary or environmental selenium, parasitism and other factors.
